The meeting was called to order at 5:30pm.

APPROVAL OF THE 19 APRIL 2006 MEETING MINUTES

The minutes were approved as distributed.

ANE NOISE COMPLAINTS FOR APRIL, MAY AND JUNE

Scott Skramstad, MAC, distributed the Noise Complaint Summary for Anoka-County-Blaine Airport for April-June 2006. In reviewing the data, **Skramstad** noted that the majority of noise complaints received are submitted via the internet and that two complainants account for approximately three-quarters of the complaints received April-June 2006. **Barbara Haake, Mounds View**, asked if the MAC could provide the name of Complainant #5 on the report; **Skramstad** stated that such information is private and will not be provided by the MAC. **Haake** then asked if it is possible to determine which operator is responsible for the noise events related to complaints submitted by Complainant #5. **Skramstad** noted that those complaints took place on different dates and at different times of the day, making it difficult to attribute the events to just one operator. **Skramstad** noted that he has met with operators at the Anoka County-Blaine Airport and reminded them of the voluntary procedures outlined in the noise abatement plan and other items related to noise abatement practices.

Joe Harris, MAC, noted that – now that its extension project is complete and it's open – Runway 9/27 will be used more often which may lessen the noise impact on residents that experienced increased operations during the Runway 9/27 closure. He stated that there will be no precision approach utilized on the south side of the airport.

OTHER ITEMS NOT ON THE AGENDA

Joe Harris, MAC, noted that he anticipates a November 2006 date for the ILS, but that that date may be pushed back to January 2007. In addition, he stated that there is a proposal before the board for the development of a restaurant on the airport's south side. He noted that the board is considering other development options for that area and other areas around the airport.

ESTABLISH NEXT MEETING DATE

The next meeting was set for 5:00pm on Wednesday, 18 October 2006. It was unanimously agreed that the Anoka County-Blaine Airport Advisory Commission meetings will begin at 5:00pm going forward.
